TOURNAMENT RULES

Please share with your team so there are no surprises later on!!

- * **All teams are guaranteed 3 games.**
- * **A coin flip will decide all home games on Saturday while play-off games will go the higher seeded team, whenever possible.**
- * **All game balls will be provided.**
- * **A team must have a minimum of 9 players to begin and end a game (minimum of 3 Females and 6 Males). Two designated courtesy runners (last possible out and female for female/male for male) are permitted. Teams can play with 9 (3F, 6M), 10 (4F, 6M) or 10+ (and substitute) or can bat their whole team as long as no more than 2 males do not bat consecutively in the line-up and any 9 or 10 can play defense with a minimum of 3 females (if playing 9) or 4 females (if playing 10 or more) playing defense.**
- * **Home-Run rule: Only 2 Over The Fence Homeruns are permitted per team per game. All other homeruns hit over the fence in excess of these will be OUTS.**
- * **The mat along with the 6 to 12 foot arc will be used for the strike zone, and the 10 run rule will be in effect for all games after the losing team has had a minimum of 5 at-bats.**
- * **If teams are tied after 7 innings in the round-robin, then the 5 player bat-off (2 Females and 3 Males) will determine the winner. In the 5 player bat-off case, the winning team will be given a +1 for runs +/- . If teams are tied after 7 innings in the playoffs, there will be a maximum of 2 extra innings with the international rule in effect (last possible out @ 2nd base). If still tied, then the 5 player bat-off will determine the winner.**
- **If three teams are tied after round robin play, the best plus/minus of games played between the tied teams will be used; if still tied, the best plus/minus of all games played will be used; if still tied, the least runs allowed in all games played will be used; if still tied, a coin flip will break the 3-way tie. Whenever a 3-way tie is broken and 2 teams remain tied, whoever defeated the other will get the higher position. For plus/minus purposes, all scores will revert back to the last complete inning (home teams do not bat in the bottom of an inning if the visiting team does not catch up in the top part of the inning), and a maximum of +/- 10 will be used for tie-breaking purposes.**
